Presets make it easy to change water or sky settings independently. Even better, the regular foggy clouds are still here. They had been deleted from the first versions of WindLight, leaving many who had built for the effects disappointed. More presets have been included for sky settings, with 'Fine Day'. with a rich blue sky, sure to be a favourite.

SCENIC

WindLight does come with a few drawbacks, however. 'Shiny' things are badly messed up, often going overboard. Avatars are darker and too shadowed. In fact, they are plain ugly. Face lamps do not help. Many residents may find themselves using First Look to take scenic photos, and then returning to the regular SL version to take photos of avatars.
