But March denied claims the authorities in China would pose problems for LL or residents: "I don't know why you worry about this. If that would happen, how could I, as well as so many other Chinese users, be in SL today?"


He also dismissed ethical concerns of doing business with the regime: "Sure China has a few more limits in a lot of ways compared with some other countries in the world. But there won't be as many restrictions about SL in China as is imagined."






