

COURT AGREEMENT

VOLKER Cattaneo has reached a settlement with Stroker Serpentine over a RL court case involving in-world copyright theft.

Cattaneo was accused by Serpentine of selling copies of his SexGen bed. His RL typist, Robert Leatherwood, had previously denied he was behind the avatar, and had ignored court summons. But the tactic backfired when Eros LLC, Serpentine's company, was awarded the case by default.

Full details of the agreement have not yet been made public.

TECH EXHIBITIONS

THE first four virtual exhibits have been chosen by The Tech museum to be recreated in RL.

The works, on the theme of science and technology assisted by art, film and music, will be built and displayed at the RL Tech Museum in June. 


