

SLERS KEEN TO TAKE RISKS IN HUNT FOR EASY MONEY BY COYNE NAGY

THE financial sector in Second Life has been repeatedly rocked by scandals - but investors are still eager to pour money into mysterious enterprises.

Residents are queueing up to invest in the Metaverse Investment Fund (MIF), despite having no idea what CEO Shaun Altman is planning to do with their money, nearly L\$3m in total. Altman is refusing to reveal what type of trades he is making, and even his own staff are apparently kept in the dark to help protect what he feels is a unique market position. 



### INTERVIEW

The AvaStar: How do you spend your time in SL? Elizabeth Tinsley: Wor-
