DISPUTES between Linden Lab and residents could soon be solved by in-world arbitration.

Claims for less than US\$10.000 will now be decided by a process carried out online, by telephone or in writing.

EXCITED

The online option means Linden Lab seem to be starting down the path of legally binding proceedings taking place inworld. Speaking to Reuters. Catherline Linden said: "We're extremely excited about arbitration centres coming to SL. If the arbitrator selected can conduct arbitration in SL, we're very much open to using SL to resolve disputes between residents and Linden Lab."

The maximum cost to the resident will be US\$185. opening the door to many new potential claimants. Some may have been put off by the previous terms insisting they travel to San Francisco to present the case in person.

But while small claims have been made easier, those wishing to go to court have been dealt a blow as lawsuits against the Lab must now be filed in San Francisco.

LS: I was at a club and it didn't take long before I realised that it was a gay club. I was hit on a lot that day but it was all in fun.




