LAB CRACKDOWN

Bv CARRIE SODWIND LINDEN Lab have launched a crackdown on lost inventories - but sceptics say results will be a long time in coming.

Hamilton Linden announced the 'Reduce Inventory Loss Initiative' on the official blog last Friday, following on from a story in The AvaStar revealing that popular freebie designer Arcadia Asylum had left SL over problems with her inventory.

ANALYSIS

Recognising that the issue has caused serious problems for many residents. Hamilton said the project would include an analysis of all reported resident inventory loss. Delilah Karas, who lost her engagement ring, said: "They spent a long time getting their act together. As I understand the problem, the loss often happens from some small glitch or hiccup in the database which then resets itself during maintenance and may be months before it happens again. I think it will be a long time before they truly solve it."

Business owner Carrie Grant said: "I wish they would advise merchants on what they should do in the mean time."


