

A DEVASTATED sim owner is following in the footsteps of a wellknown content creator by storming out of SL.

The AvaStar revealed last week that Laukosargas Svarog, designer of the virtual ecosystem Svarga and idyllic Lauks Nest sims, had said she would

no longer work in SL. Although her creations will continue to exist in SL, her departure has had an affect on some of her friends. Lukas Mensing, the current owner of Lauks Nest, had not seen Svarog online since October, but it was the article in The AvaStar last week which confirmed she was going. He said: "As Laukosargas is doing. I'm leaving SL too. I'm so sorrv it's turning this way." Svarog is one of several designers who left the world recently due to copyright risks. In a blog post before she left, she wrote: "I've given up now. Too much threat of RL litigation and no protection either from Linden Lab or anywhere else."
